

Pharmacy Preceptor Training Course 2026

Module 1: General Preceptor Course

Introduction

The course frames the partnership journey of the preceptor and the trainee in the developmental experience for the learner; from preparation, onboarding into real world practice and the lived experience of precepting and nurturing the trainee into a full-fledged pharmacist.

Course Objectives

This course aims to help participants to:

- Understand the goals of preceptorship, the roles, responsibilities and expectations of a preceptor
- Understand self-leadership in order to effectively lead others
- Discuss the importance of ethical practice, professionalism, interpersonal and communication skills
- Learn and practice how to precept and coach (include learning styles, teaching approaches, questioning, clinical reasoning)
- Learn and practice how to give feedback objectively and effectively
- Learn and practice how to do assessment in the developmental continuum
- Discuss the importance of motivational skills including handling of Generation Z
- Learn the changes involved in transiting to the new assessment methodology
- Discuss the challenges of precepting and how to overcome them
- Discuss the key success factors for the preceptor in achieving optimal training for the trainee

Module 2: Workplace Based Assessment (WBA)

Introduction

The course aims to prepare existing preceptors for SPC's revised Pre-registration Pharmacist Training and Assessment Framework 2025, to familiarise with Entrustable Professional Activity (EPA) concepts and the various WBA tools like MiniCEX, Case Base Discussion (CBD), and Summative Portfolio Assessment.

Course objectives:

- Entrustable Professional Activity (EPA) concepts
- Anatomy of an EPA
- Overview of PAs for revised framework
- Introduction to WBAs and Extended Discussion

Segment 1: Mini-CEX

- Part 1A: Focusing on Professional Activity 3 and using the Mini-CEX form
- Part 1B: Mini-CEX Extended Discussion and making decision on supervision level

Segment 2: Case Base Discussion

- Part 2A: Focusing on Professional Activity 1 and using the CBD form
- Part 2B: CBD Extended Discussion and making decision on supervision level

Segment 3: Summative portfolio review

- Orientation to sample portfolio
- Portfolio review (PR1 direct patient care rotation):
- Form B2, Mini-CEX, CBD, Multisource Feedback, Drug Information Log, Continuing Professional Development Plan
- Determine the progression or remediation for the preregistration pharmacist
