

# Pharmacist Preceptor's Training Programme

## PROGRAMME OUTLINE

The Pharmacist Preceptors' Training Programme (PPTP) aims to promote the development of foundational teaching skills for pharmacist preceptors. The modules are constructed around themes that support individual participant's learning in their specific teaching context.

This full PPTP offered by NHG Health, is conducted over 2 days, where Day 1 (Foundational) is accredited by the Singapore Pharmacy Council (SPC) for meeting the requirements to be a Preceptor for Pre-Registration Pharmacists. Day 2 seeks to introduce further capabilities of curriculum design and principles of assessments which will enhance your role as preceptors. Pharmacists are strongly encouraged to attend the full programme of 2 days, or may choose to attend Day 1 only for meeting SPC requirements.

## LEARNING OUTCOMES


### Foundational

1. Outline the goals of preceptorship, the professional activities and expectations of a preceptor
2. Describe the values expected of a preceptor.
3. Employ effective communication skills to provide feedback to pre-registration pharmacists
4. Develop teaching, precepting, coaching and supervisory skills
5. Plan activities to support teaching and learning
6. Conduct appropriate assessments adequately, including the use of work-based assessment tools and professional activities
7. Facilitate constructive and reflective feedback to enhance learning.
8. Apply self-leadership in order to effectively lead others
9. Adopt a growth mindset to reflect on own practice and identify areas for improvement

### Intermediate

1. Interpret and apply the Taxonomies of Learning;
2. Apply Goal Analysis in relation to instructional needs, goals and outcomes for learners;
3. Develop clear and specific learning objectives in alignment with your educational goals;
4. Describe and apply the Principles of Assessment for a broad range of evaluations;
5. Identify appropriate assessment tools and techniques for assessing learning outcomes;
6. Enhance your constructive feedback to learners to promote professional development


