Dear Parents/ Guardians

We hope the girls had a good September break after an exciting Term 3. Students participated actively in various activities, such as National Day Celebration, Catholic Education Sunday, National School Games, Mathematics and Science Olympiads, National Schools Literature Festival, Arts Presentation and competitions. The Sec 3 students also went on our inaugural MOE-OBS Challenge in August. Such learning experiences enable the girls to build their character and discover and develop their interests and strengths, and we thank parents and volunteers for your support.

In this letter, we will be sharing information on school matters in Term 4.

1. Supporting Students during Exam Period

During the Teachers' Day Mass at the close of Term 3, a special blessing was offered for our graduating cohort as they prepare to sit for their national exams. For Sec 1 to 3 students, the End-of-Year Examination is a culminating assessment where students apply the knowledge and skills they have learnt over the year. Excellence remains a cornerstone of our school values, and as each girl endeavours to achieve her personal best, let us remind her that her worth is not defined by her accomplishments and that God has good plans for her.

Let us also support the girls' well-being by ensuring that they have sufficient rest during this period. To provide students with more time for revision, CCA has stopped on 28 August and will resume on 14 October.

2. Key School Events in Term 4

a. Sec 1 to 3 Post-Examination Programme

As the school is used as a venue for the GCE O-Level written examinations, Sec 1 to 3 students will be dismissed earlier on some days during their post-examination period and the CCA start time will also be adjusted accordingly. Do note that reporting times remain as usual — 7:35 a.m. daily, except for Thursdays where students report at 8:35 a.m. Please refer to the dismissal timings in the table on the next page.

The Sec 1 to 3 post-examination timetable will be issued to the students nearer the date. As students will be reporting at 8.35 a.m. and dismissed at 11.50 a.m. on 15 October, there will be no recess on that day. Students are advised to have their breakfast before coming to school.

b. Independent Learning Day (ILD) on 19 Oct

Students will be having their last ILD on 19 Oct. During this ILD, they are to complete the following modules on SLS. Each module should take approximately 30 – 40 minutes. Instructions will be emailed to the students on 19 Oct.

- Introduction to Gemini Notebook for sec 3

In addition, students should use the time to prepare for their Student-Initiated Learning (SIL) presentation - a class-based sharing with their peers on 20 or 21 October. We encourage you to talk to your daughter/ward about her learning experience!

c. Meet-The-Parents Session (MTPS) Sign-Up

During the MTPS between 23 to 30 October 2026, you will have the opportunity to meet your child's/ward's teacher over Google Meet to discuss your child's/ward's holistic development and progress in the school. The form for appointment booking will be available on Parents Gateway from 1 October, Thursday till 6 October, Tuesday. Booking of appointments is open to all parents/guardians, and your desired time slot is subject to availability.

d. Sec 3 Academic Programme

The last day of school for Sec 1 and 2 students is 22 October 2026, Thursday. Sec 3 students will continue to have lessons from 26 to 30 October as part of their Academic Programme. The information on Sec 3 Academic Programme will be sent via Parents Gateway nearer the date.
