Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are almost there. Term 4 is the final chapter of 2026, and I wanted to write to you — not just with updates, but with genuine gratitude.

When I look back at 2026, my first feeling is gratitude. Gratitude to our teachers who show up every day with care and commitment. Gratitude to our parents who trust us with your children. Gratitude for our students who try, even when it is hard. We have not got everything right this year. But I see a school that is learning alongside our students, reflecting, adjusting, and growing. That, to me, is something worth acknowledging as we head into the final term together.

Keeping the joy of learning alive.

As we enter Term 4, I want to gently offer this to every family: please do not let this period extinguish your child's love for learning. Grades matter, but they are not the whole story. We want every child graduating from CCKPS to be prepared for life, not just the next exam, still curious, still willing to try, still believing they are capable. Their learning and adventure continue after Primary 6!

Our motto is Excellence Through Discipline and Diligence. But excellence, to me, is not about being the best. It is about doing your best, consistently and honestly, even when it is hard.

I shared an image with my teachers recently that has stayed with me. On one side, a hand pours knowledge into an empty head: "This is not teaching." On the other, a flame is lit at the heart of a child: "This is." That is what we are trying to do at CCKPS — not just fill your child with information but awaken something in them. Curiosity. Confidence. The belief that they are capable of more than they think. You are doing the same at home, whether you realise it or not. When you ask your child what they found interesting today instead of just what mark they got, you are lighting that flame too.

A word to our P6 families

We want those PSLE doors to be as wide open as possible for your child, and our teachers have worked hard all year toward that. But please hold this alongside something equally true — your child is more than their AL score. The way they have grown, the friendships built, the moments they pushed through something hard and came out the other side. Do not let one set of results be the only story you tell.
