EXTENSION OF VOLUNTARY CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION PHASE FOR ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

The Allied Health Professions Council (AHPC) would like to acknowledge all registered Allied Health Professionals (AHPs) and Continuing Professional Education (CPE) providers for their participation and support during the voluntary CPE phase which started on 1 March 2024.

- 2. The AHPC has received many useful suggestions and feedback concerning the CPE framework and system as well as user experience with the online system. We are currently reviewing the suggestions and feedback. To enable some of the suggestions to be incorporated into the online system, which would require some time to implement, the AHPC will extend the voluntary CPE phase by one year, concluding on 31 December 2026. This extension will provide additional time for the AHPC to collect further feedback whilst enabling more Allied Health Professionals to test the system.
- 3. The table below elaborates the CPE requirement for each Practising Certificate (PC) Renewal cycle:

PC expiring on	Due to renew PC from	Is CPE required for PC renewal?
31 Dec 2026	Oct – Dec 2026	No
31 Dec 2027	Oct – Dec 2027	No
31 Dec 2028	Oct – Dec 2028	Yes
31 Dec 2029	Oct – Dec 2029	Yes
31 Dec 2030	Oct – Dec 2030	Yes
