- 6) Report to the examination venue for morning assembly on the days you have papers. You will be dismissed from school after completing the day's papers.
- 7) If you do not have any papers for the day, you are not required to report to school.
- 8) If you only have a second paper for the day, you must be at the examination venue at least 30 minutes before the start of that paper.
- 9) Leave your bags outside the classroom.
