Points for All Students to Note

1. Reporting Venue

- Students offering **G2 and G3 subjects** are to report at their respective **form class**.
- Students offering **G1 subjects** are to report at **Classroom D1C**.

2. Venues for English Language Listening Comprehension (LC):

a. EL (G3)

- 2R1 → CR 2R1
- 2R2 → CR 2R2
- 2R3 → CR 2R3
- 2R4 and 2R5 → CR 2R4
- 2R6 and 2R7 → CR 2R5

b. EL (G2)

- 2R1, 2R2, 2R3 & 2R5 → CR 2R6
- 2R4, 2R6 & 2R7 → CR 2R7

c. EL (G1)

- CR D1C
