2. **PSLE Matters**

PSLE Listening Comprehension will take place on Tuesday, 15 September 2026. It will be a **no-school day** for all Primary 1 to 5 Lasallians. Teachers will inform Lasallians of their assignments for that day.

4. Year-End School Holiday Travel Advisory & Declaration

School requires parents/guardians to make a travel declaration for your child/ward only if he/she intends to travel for the year-end school holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS]. Please declare your child's/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by **Friday, 30 October 2026**. Only one parent is required to declare.

If your child/ward is not travelling during the year-end holidays, no action is required on your side.

5. Be Aware and Be Safe

As the September holidays are drawing near, we would like to remind our parents/guardians to ensure the safety of your child/ward of the following:

- Do not loiter at public places on his/her own;
- Do not speak to strangers or follow them;
- Say 'No' if anyone tries to offer him/her suspicious items (for example, vapes); and
- Be careful who he/she is talking to online.

For the safety of our students, please remind your child or ward to head home promptly after school and not to loiter in the neighbourhood. We have reminded our Lasallians to uphold our school values, be considerate towards our neighbours, and play their part in fostering a caring and united community.
