



Mdm Jasmine Tan Bee Yew

Named as one of the 20 Mass High Tech's Women to Watch
Conferred the Silver Stevie Award for Top Female
Executives of the Year

Mdm Jasmine Tan Bee Yew's remarkable story began in a kampong in Bukit Panjang and continues to unfold today in Boston, 9954 miles away. Growing up in an extended family of 47 members, it was hard for her to find a place to study at home but she persevered. With the encouragement of her mother, who impressed upon her the value of education, Mdm Tan worked diligently both at home and in school.

As a student, Mdm Tan was heavily involved in several co-curricular activities including Girl Guides, Choir and the Mathematics Club. These fostered in her qualities such as independence, self-confidence and creativity. She also developed the mindset to do whatever was necessary in order to reach her goals, qualities which enabled her to give of her best and to excel. In 1981, she graduated from St. Margaret's Secondary School. Mdm Tan went on to Anglo-Chinese Junior College before graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science from the National University of Singapore. Subsequently, she worked for three years with Singapore Press Holdings before leaving for the United States. There, Mdm Tan worked full-time and studied part-time to earn herself a Master of Science degree in Information Science at Boston University.

A lifelong learner, Mdm Tan then earned certifications - the coveted Project Management Professional credential from the Project Management Institute, ITIL VS from Loyalist Certification Services, and Scrum Master from Scrum Alliance. Accreditation from such renowned institutions in the United States gave her the skill sets necessary to handle IT projects and human resource. In 2014, Mdm Tan was named as one of the 20 Mass High Tech's Women to Watch and conferred the Silver Stevie Award for Top Female Executives of the Year. In the same year, she was recognized as one of the world's top managed services providers (MSP) and named MSPMentor 250, as well as one of the up-and-coming women to watch by technology news provider, The Channel Company. For her achievements, Mdm Tan was also featured in the book *Innovative Women: How the World's Top Female Entrepreneurs Make it Happen*.

Mdm Tan (now known as Mrs Jasmine Lombardi) has held a number of senior management positions in technology companies in the United States. For three years starting September 2013, she served as the Vice President of Partner Success at Intronis MSP Solutions (by Barracuda), an award-winning provider of world-class cloud backup solutions. Since October 2016, she has taken on the dynamic and challenging role as the Chief Customer Officer of Locus Robotics, where she provides leadership in business development and operations management in the logistics industry. As a career woman, a wife, and mother to four children, Mdm Tan belongs to a select group of women who have juggled work and family well. She has paved the way for future generations of Asian women living in the USA and elsewhere.
