NDP 2026 Packs Feature Unique Artworks by Artists with Disabilities

1. The NDP 2026 Executive Committee (EXCO) has partnered SG Enable to bring together artists with disabilities from different ages and organisations to co-create artworks for this year's NDP Packs. The collaboration with SG Enable reflects the commitment to build a more inclusive Singapore, which promotes greater awareness and positive action for disability inclusion.
2. President Tharman Shanmugaratnam met with many of these artists at the National Stadium today, who shared more about their inspirations behind their artworks. Thanking them for designing the NDP Pack artworks, President Tharman said, "Each artist has taken pride in contributing to the design of the NDP Packs. They also show once again how individuals, differently abled, help to connect us all as Singaporeans."
3. A total of 36 artists, ranging from ages six to 65, have come together to co-create the artworks for six unique NDP Packs this year. They represent a diverse group, from 21 Special Education (SPED) schools, nine Social Service Agencies (SSAs), and for the first time, two Early Intervention Centres. Each artwork in the NDP Packs encapsulates the artists' interpretation of the NDP theme "Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!" and their heartfelt wishes for the nation's birthday. Through their contributions, these artists demonstrate how shared experiences and aspirations unite us as Singaporeans.

Chairman of the NDP 2026 Pack Committee, Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) Chong Guan Tat said, "Together with our partner SG Enable, this year's collaboration reflects our continued commitment to fostering a more inclusive Singapore. This year marks the first time artists from the Early Intervention Centres are involved in the NDP Pack artwork creation. This provides a meaningful and powerful platform for the young artists to showcase their talents, recognise their abilities, and share their diverse lenses with fellow Singaporeans. Drawing from their strengths, the artists have co-created six pieces of beautiful artworks which will be featured on this year's NDP Packs, giving us inspiration to go beyond. On behalf of the NDP 2026 EXCO, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to the 36 artists, as well as their parents, teachers and caregivers, for being part of this NDP 2026 journey."

CEO of SG Enable, Ms Lee May Gee added, "This year's theme 'Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!' speaks to the heart of SG Enable's work, encouraging fellow Singaporeans to go beyond their first impressions of persons with disabilities, and to recognise their talents, creativity and strengths. The continuing partnership between the NDP EXCO and SG Enable reflects our nation's commitment to disability inclusion. We are heartened that this year's National Day Parade Packs feature artwork by pre-schoolers with disabilities, showing that inclusion can start from a young age."
