The national examinations are around the corner and we wish all our Primary 6 students all the best! Let us give them the fullest support they need to excel. Please take note of the PSLE dates that may affect normal school operations for the other levels.

PSLE Listening Comprehension (LC) Examination – Tuesday, 15 September 2026

The PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination for P6 students will be held on Tuesday, 15 September 2026. P6 students are to report punctually to the school hall by 8.00 a.m. Students who are exempted from Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) are to report to the school hall at 10.15 a.m. **P1 to P5 students do not need to report to school** that day.

Study Break before PSLE – Monday to Wednesday, 21–23 September 2026

As communicated on 29 June 2026 (Reference number: TPPS/31/2026), P6 students will be on Study Break from Monday to Wednesday, 21–23 September 2026. P6 students are to refer to the lesson schedule and Zoom details that will be shared with them before the start of the study break.

School hours **remain unchanged for all P1 to P5 students** during this period.

PSLE Written Examinations – Thursday to Wednesday, 24-30 September 2026

The PSLE Written Examinations will be held from Thursday to Wednesday, 24-30 September 2026. All P6 students are to report punctually to their respective examination rooms by 7.15 a.m. and will be dismissed at the end of each paper. Please refer to the PSLE Information Booklet for more details.
