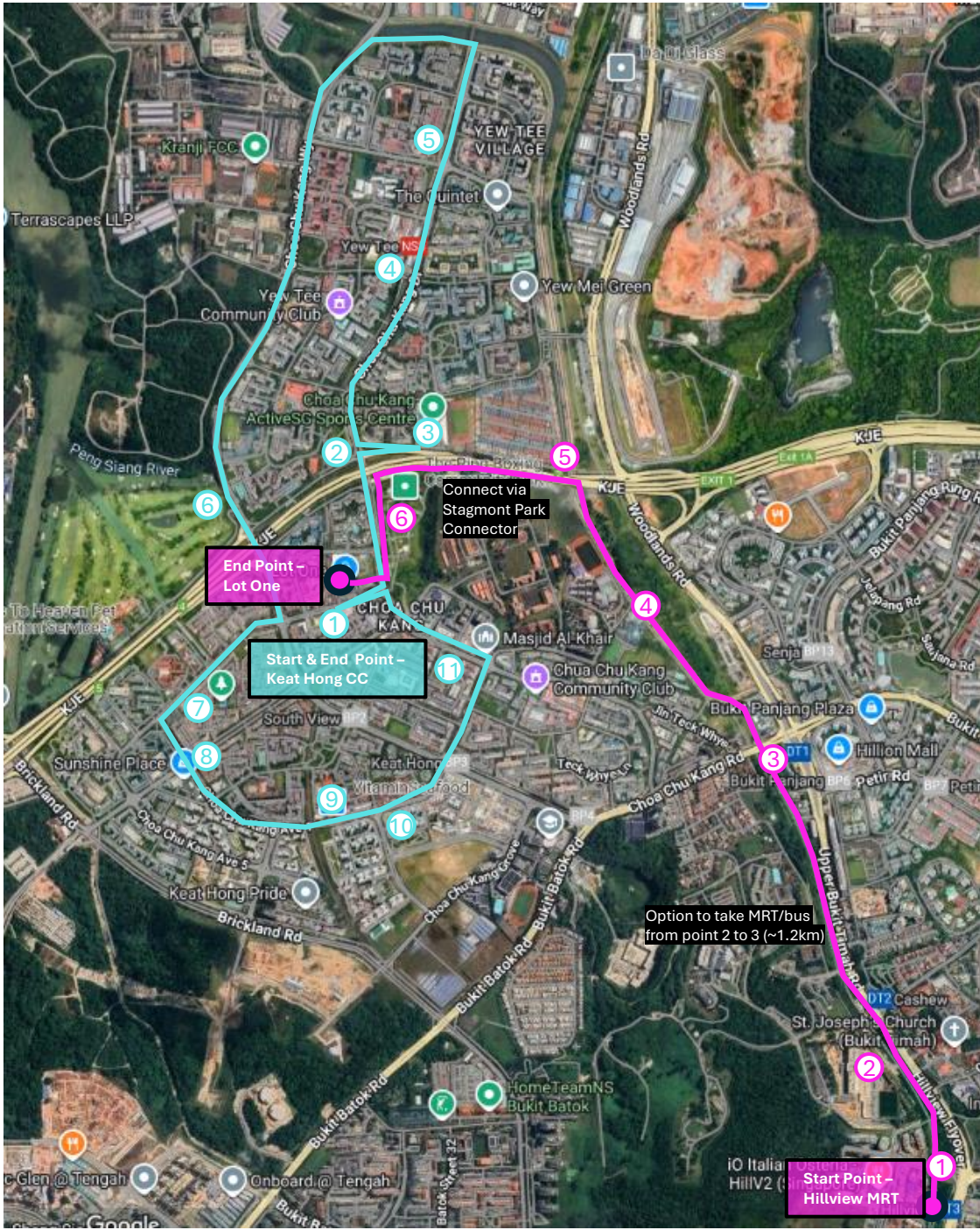

Come 2027, residents can look forward to Heart of Yew Tee, next to Yew Tee Point. It will feature 2-room flexi flats for seniors, integrated with a variety of amenities like a new hawker centre, community club, polyclinic, retail shops and a community plaza.

Warren Golf & Country Club's land has been earmarked for residential development in the Draft Master Plan 2025. This is part of a larger initiative to repurpose land previously used for golf courses to address housing needs and other urban development goals.

Various social and recreational spaces have been introduced along selected sections of the North-South Line MRT viaduct which runs through the town. These spaces are strategically located near residential areas to foster community bonding, encourage a healthy lifestyle as well as enrich residents' recreational experiences.

Built on the site of the former Lam Soon Community Centre, The Arena @ Keat Hong was designed to be inclusive and offers barrier-free access.

Keat Hong Shopping Centre is part of the Remaking of Heartlands (ROH) programme in Choa Chu Kang and will be upgraded in the coming years.
