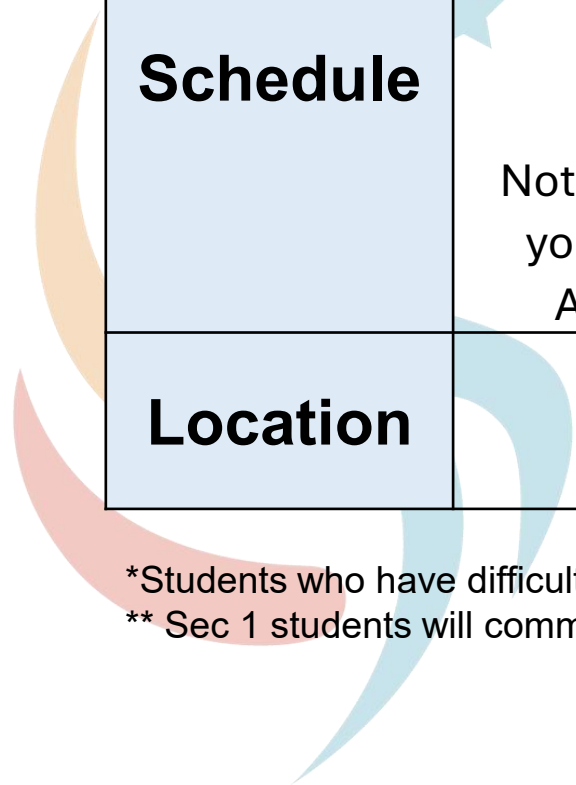

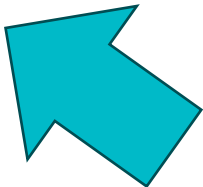
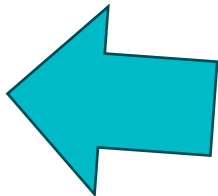

Important Info on HBL

- **The submission of HBL assignments will be closely monitored**
 - HBL assignments must be submitted by 3.30pm of the HBL day
 - S1 students T1 submission deadline: 3.30pm on following school day
- **Consequences** will be served swiftly for non-submission of HBL assignment. This includes:

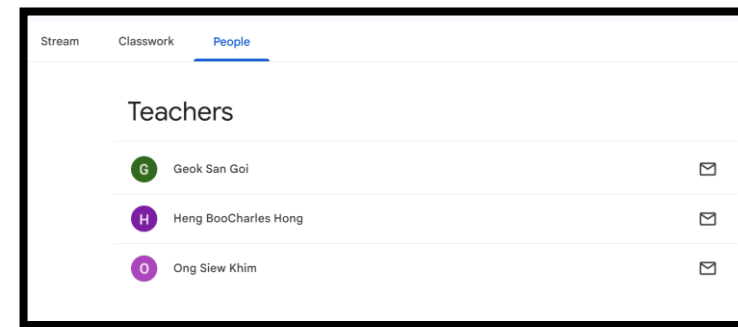

Prior to HBL day,

Scenario 1

Scenario 2

Scenario 2a

contact/email Form teacher ASAP, showing your MC as proof

Scenario 3
