 - **Stand down from CCAs in end Term 1** for graduating students to provide time for revision and close learning gaps.

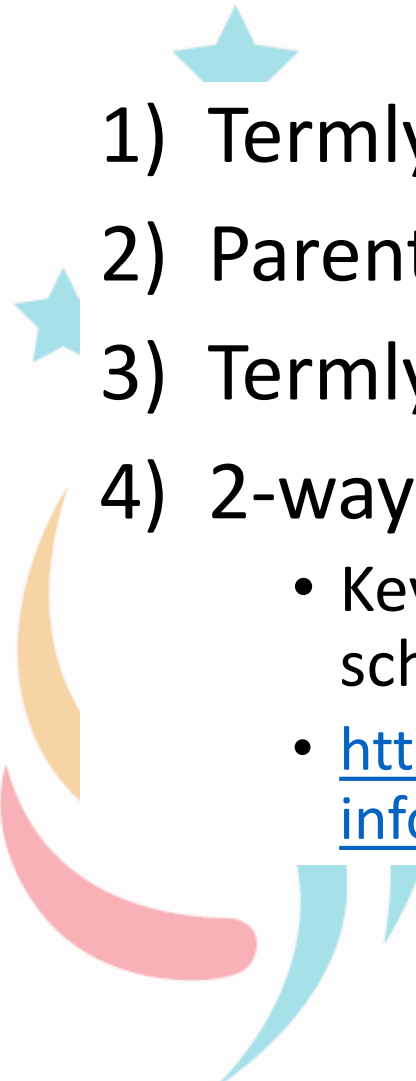
