Welcome to the new school semester! We hope you had a restful break. As we begin Term 3, we look forward to continuing our partnership to provide a rewarding and enriching experience for your child/ward.

Accolades

We are pleased to share our students' achievements in the National School Games (NSG), Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) Arts Presentation and the Singapore & Asian Schools Math Olympiad (SASMO) 2026. Well -done, Elights!

National School Games (NSG)

Volleyball Senior Girls achieved a Top 8 placing in League 2, while our Football Senior Boys advanced to 2nd place in League 1. In Wushu, our Junior Boys (Individual) clinched multiple awards across three events, taking 1st in 5-Duan Changquan, 2nd in 5-Duan Broadsword, and 6th in 1st International Cudgel. Our Junior Girls (Group) also performed well, finishing 5th in the Weapon category. In Taekwondo, our student clinched 2nd place in the Senior Girls Individual Poomsae Yellow 7 event. In Swimming, our Senior Girls swimmer earned 3rd place in the 50m Backstroke and 50m Freestyle, 4th place in the 100m Butterfly, 5th place in the 100m Backstroke, and 7th place in both the 50m Butterfly and 50m Breaststroke events. In Rhythmic Gymnastics, our student attained 6th place in the Senior Girls Developmental Clubs category.

Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) Arts Presentation

Malay Dance, Fusion & Modern Dance, and Guzheng Ensemble each attained a Certificate of Accomplishment, while Indian Dance attained a Certificate of Distinction.

Singapore & Asian Schools Math Olympiad (SASMO) 2026

Our students achieved a total of 1 Gold, 4 Silver, 13 Bronze and 6 Honourable Mentions.

Administrative Matters

Following the National Environment Agency's launch of Singapore's nationwide Beverage Container Return Scheme (BCRS) on 1 Apr 2026, all MOE schools will be implementing this initiative. The scheme encourages mindful consumption, proper recycling habits, and reduced littering whilst creating a clean stream of recyclables.

The BCRS applies a 10-cent deposit on beverages in plastic and metal containers (150ml-3L). This deposit is refunded when containers are returned to designated "Return Right" Reverse Vending Machines (RVMs). Only containers bearing the scheme's deposit mark are eligible for refunds.

Starting 29 June 2026, our drinks stallholder will charge the 10-cent deposit directly to students.

Students are encouraged to develop responsible recycling habits by returning empty containers to RVMs located outside school premises. Refunds will be processed digitally through EZ-Link cards or DBS PayLah!. Whilst rinsing is not required for refunds, we encourage students to empty and rinse containers before returning them as a good recycling practice and to address hygiene concerns.

Co-Curricular Matters

CCA will resume in Term 3. Primary 6 students are not required to attend CCA from Term 3 onwards. Parents are encouraged to refer to the school calendar on www.eastspringpri.moe.edu.sg for the general CCA schedule. Students are strongly encouraged to attend every CCA session. If your child/ward is unable to attend, please inform the CCA teachers-in-charge.
