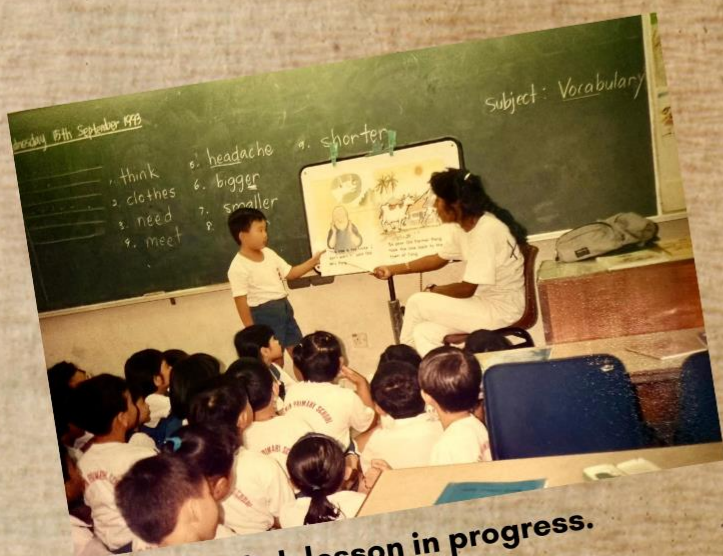
The school was officially opened on 25 April 1987. Mr Koh L. P., the Guest-of-Honour giving the opening address at the official opening ceremony.
