LOOK AFTER THE SAFETY OF OUR JIEMINITES TOGETHER

Jieminites understand the importance of road safety, as most of them walk to school every day. They are aware of the do's and don'ts when crossing the road and most importantly, all Jieminites are required to know the Kerb Drill.

SUMMARY:
MASTER THE RULES

☒ Do not jaywalk and always use designated crossings

☒ Do not dash across the road especially when the green man is flashing

☒ Obey the green and red man signal lights

☒ Avoid crossing in front of or between stationary vehicles, or in vehicles' blind spots as the drivers would not be able to see you

☒ Do not use your phone when crossing the road

☒ Do not chat with your friends while crossing the road. Pay attention to the traffic instead

SUMMARY:
Crossing the road using the Kerb Drill when there is an oncoming traffic

☒ Look right if oncoming traffic is from the right

☒ Look left if oncoming traffic is from the left

☒ Look right/left again

☒ Ensure all vehicles have stopped

☒ Raise your hand when crossing

We would like to take this opportunity to remind parents who drive their child/children to school to take note of the following :

- Kindly cooperate with the road marshals in school at all times.
- Please do not drop off/pick up your child along Yishun Street 71 and Yishun Ring Road. Please refrain from doing this as it may cause unnecessary delay and safety risks for your child/children and the other road users.
- For parents who do not wish to drop off your child in school, you may choose any one of the nearby carparks to do so.
