NOTIFICATION TO PARENTS (TERM 4/2026)

1. **Term 4 School Calendar and Days of School Closure due to PSLE Examinations and Marking.** As there are several days of school closure due to the PSLE examinations and marking, do take note of these dates and make the necessary childcare arrangements.
 - a. Annex A lists the schedule of events for Term 4.
 - b. Annex B delineates the content to be tested for the Primary 3 to Primary 5 End of Year Examination as well as for the Term 4 Primary 1 and Primary 2 Non-Weighted Assessment.
2. **Term 4 Day 1.** Students will receive their Term 4 timetable on the first day of Term 4. Students are to bring their stationery and the usual English, Mathematics and MTL learning resources, as lessons will resume from 9.10 a.m. after our termly Start Right Programme.
3. **Traffic Safety and Consideration for Residents.** The school again seeks cooperation to prevent potential traffic accidents. This is especially at the front gate when dropping off or picking up your child/ward. Due to the heavy traffic conditions of vehicles travelling along the road and pedestrians crossing the walkway outside of the gate along Hougang Ave 8 (main road outside the school), any stoppage or obstruction caused by unauthorized picking up/ dropping off by vehicles at our front gate would constitute a breach of safety. The school continues to observe that some drivers have been causing an unsafe situation when they stop and block our school entrance. This further causes more congestion on the road. Please help to role-model safety practices by dropping off or picking up your child/ward at any of the HDB car parks next to the side gate.
4. Please make full use of all available public car parks near the school to prevent congestion and avoid bottlenecks. If you encounter congestion, remain patient and avoid using your car horn, as it will disturb residents. Additionally, ensure that your child/ward behaves considerately outside of school by avoiding loud noises and running/playing in the car parks. These actions can cause distress and pose safety concerns. Your support in reinforcing the school's values of Respect and Compassion will foster good relations with the local community.
5. For students and parents who cycle to school, please exercise care and consideration to pedestrians. All cyclists are recommended to wear appropriate protective gear as recommended by LTA. For students who are riding to school, they must register with our Operations Manager to

complete a Riders Safety briefing, please help to inform the school if your child/ward is a rider for the school to conduct the said safety briefing for them.

6. ***Safe and appropriate behaviour in our school buses.*** For parents whose children are taking the school bus, please reinforce our message that it is a requirement for all children to always wear seat belts when in the school bus. We seek your help in iterating to your child/ward of the importance of wearing their seat belts and always remaining seated while in the school bus. Repeated failure to wear seat belts can result in the bus company preventing your child/ward from using the school bus services. Parents are also encouraged to give the school any feedback on any school bus safety related concerns, and we will follow up with the bus company. On a similar note, the bus captains are asked to give their feedback to the school on any safety concern due to students' behaviour such as not wearing seat belts, behaving rowdily to distract the drivers etc. The school has put in place these regulations to ensure school bus safety is not compromised. We appreciate the support of parents, bus captains, and students in upholding these expectations. Together, we can ensure that every child travels to and from school safely and responsibly.
7. ***Leaving School during Curriculum Hours.*** With reference to the Student Handbook page 21, we would like to reiterate to parents/guardians that any student who leaves the school during curriculum hours must obtain permission from their parents or guardians and inform the Form/Subject/CCA Teacher accordingly. We wish to highlight that no student is allowed to leave the school before After-School Programmes without prior consent. Students who do not adhere to the school rules will be subject to disciplinary action. This is an area the school will continue to keep under close review.
8. ***Children's Day Celebration.*** The school will celebrate Children's Day on 1 Oct 2026 (Thu), and students will be dismissed at 10.30 a.m. As part of our promotion for our children to read and to encourage creativity, this year's Children's Day celebration bears the theme of "Stories Come Alive". We invite all students to come dressed as characters from folktales of ASEAN. The English Language teachers would have engaged students from Term 3 Week 8 with ASEAN folktales during library periods and led them in designing their costumes for the celebration proper on 1 Oct. In line with our school's spirit, students are strongly encouraged to design their costumes using recyclable or reusable materials. This is a wonderful opportunity for our students to become Green Makers while expressing their creativity. As part of the celebrations, we are also thrilled to host Mr Daryl Kho, one of Singapore's best-selling and award-winning authors, for Author Talk. This is an inspiring opportunity for students to hear from a celebrated writer and learn more about the world of writing and books. Following Children's Day, we will be holding a Book Fair during recess on 7 Oct and 8 Oct. To further enrich the Children's Day spirit, fun and engaging activities have been planned for all students throughout the celebration.
9. ***Deepavali Celebrations.*** As Deepavali falls on 8 Nov 2026 (Sun), 9 Nov 2026 (Mon) will be a public holiday. Deepavali celebrations in school will be held on 13 Nov 2026 (Fri).
10. ***Post PSLE Programme for P6 Students.*** Attendance is compulsory after PSLE as lessons will continue. Meaningful and interesting activities have been planned for the students. There will also be sessions to guide our students on their transition to secondary schooling.
11. ***CCA Programme.*** The final session for all after-school CCA will be on 29 Sep 2026 (Tue) and resumes only from 3 Nov 2026 (Tue) onwards.

12. **PE Programme.** We will be having our P5 OAL at MOE Jalan Bahtera Campsite from 12 Oct (Mon) to 14 Oct 2026 (Wed). The Outdoor Adventure Learning 3D2N Camp aims to instill a sense of resilience and our school values in our students. More details will be provided over PG.

14. **Term 4 Student Check-in Survey.** The survey will provide an opportunity for us to understand students' sentiments towards Term 4 and how students are managing challenges that they may be facing. 15. **Holistic Development Report (HDP) and Student Awards.** The HDP is used to provide a comprehensive and inclusive way of recognising your child's/ward's efforts and achievements through personal qualities and learning dispositions. This includes consolidated feedback from all teachers (Form Teachers, subject teachers and CCA teachers) who have interacted with your child/ward throughout the semester. To recognise students for their year-long achievements, the student award process includes referencing from the HDP. Your child's/ward's progress in personal qualities will be reflected in his report book at the end of each semester. With strong home-school partnership, we can nurture the personal qualities in the HDP together for your child's/ward's growth.
