Here are some of the updates for September 2026.

1. Teachers' Day Celebrations (3 September 2026) and Teachers' Day holiday (4 September 2026)

The school will be celebrating Teachers' Day on **Thursday, 3 September**. Students are to report to school as usual at 7.30 a.m. for a morning of fun-filled activities to celebrate and show appreciation for our teachers. As there will be no recess on this day, students are reminded to bring their own snacks. **All students will be dismissed at 10.30 a.m.** Our Student Care Centre (SCC) will continue to be open for students who are in SCC.
