Dear Parents

We welcome our students back to a new semester and hope that all parents and students manage to spend quality family time together during the June school vacation!

The following are the major school activities and programmes for July and early August.

1) Youth Day School Holiday

The Youth Day School Holiday is on Monday 6 July. Lessons resume on Tuesday 7 July.

2) Class Photo Taking Session

The annual class photo-taking sessions will take place over two days – Thursday 9 July and Friday 10 July.

3) National Education (NE) Show for P5 students

The NE show for all Primary 5 students will be held on Saturday 18 July. The show is held at the National Stadium and parents of P5 students will receive more information soon.

4) EDP Hybrid Open House

Our school will be having a virtual Open House on our school's website and holding a simple physical Open House on the morning of Saturday 18 July at 9.00 am. 5) Rainbow Day 2 (Racial Harmony Day)

8) Traffic and Road Safety

Illegal parking along Admiralty Link (Gate A)

We have observed vehicles being parked along Admiralty Link, particularly just before Gate A, during afternoon dismissal and Student Care Centre (SCC) pick-up times. This practice poses significant safety concerns and disrupts traffic flow, especially for public buses. Additionally, these parked vehicles obstruct the line of sight for vehicles exiting our school premises onto Admiralty Link.

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To address these concerns, we would like to highlight that the school provides ample parking facilities between 4.30 pm and 6.30 pm. Parents fetching children from the SCC are welcome to utilize these parking facilities by informing our security personnel, who will grant temporary access for pick-up purposes.

Your cooperation in using the designated parking areas would significantly enhance road safety and traffic management along Admiralty Link, ensuring the wellbeing of our students, staff, and the wider community.

Illegal Parking & Inconsiderate Driving Along the Service Road (Blk 404A Admiralty Link)

HDB has received numerous feedback regarding illegal parking along the service road adjacent to our school at Blk 404A Multistorey Car Park (MSCP) Admiralty Link. This tends to occur during school drop-off and dismissal hours, and the vehicles involved are largely believed to belong to parents of our students. The illegal parking and inconsiderate 3-point turns made at the exit point of the MSCP, have created dangerous conditions - for drivers, their passengers, members of the public and particularly for our students who cross this road on their way to and from school.

We strongly urge parents to refrain from using the service road as a drop-off or pick-up point, and to make use of the nearby car parks instead. You may also drop your child off at our school's car porch every morning where it would be much safer. This would significantly reduce inconvenience to other road users and will also greatly improve visibility and safety for all drivers, members of the public and our students crossing the service road.

Thank you for your understanding and support in maintaining a safe environment for all.
